- The Head of the department should take the necessary steps to maintain a congenial relation among department's faculties.



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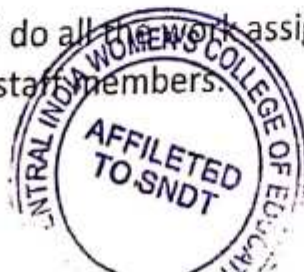
